

BLACKJACK SIDE BET RULES AND INSTRUCTIONS

ROYAL MATCH 21

The Deluxe version of Royal Match 21® is an optional bonus bet for blackjack that considers your first two cards. If the cards are the same suit or a Royal Match (king and queen suited), you win.....and then you have a choice:

- Collect your proceeds; or
- Parlay your proceeds onto your main blackjack bet and play the hand out.

Playing the Game

1. To begin each round, make a standard blackjack wager and the optional Royal Match wager.
 2. The dealer then follows house procedures for blackjack.
 3. Once you have two cards, the dealer settles the Royal Match wagers. If you have two suited cards, they win according to the payable. If you win, you may collect the proceeds or parlay any amount of them onto your main blackjack bet and play the hand out.
- If your first two cards are not suited, you lose the Royal Match wager.

KING'S BOUNTY

The Deluxe version of King's Bounty® is an optional bonus bet for blackjack that considers your first two cards. If they add up to 20 (hard or soft), you win.....and then you have a choice:

- Collect your proceeds; or
- Parlay your proceeds onto your main blackjack bet and play the hand out.

Playing the Game

1. To begin each round, make a standard blackjack wager and the optional King's Bounty wager.
 2. The dealer then follows house procedures for blackjack.
 3. Once you have two cards, the dealer settles the King's Bounty wagers. If your first two cards add up to 20 (hard or soft), you win according to the payable. You may collect the proceeds or parlay any amount of them onto your main blackjack bet and play the hand out.
- If your first two cards do not sum to 20, you lose the King's Bounty wager.

Bet the Set "21"

The Deluxe version of Bet the Set "21"® is an optional bonus bet for blackjack that considers your first two cards. If the cards are a pair or a suited pair, you win.....and then you have a choice:

- Collect your proceeds; or
- Parlay your proceeds onto your main blackjack bet and play the hand out.

Playing the Game

1. To begin each round, make a standard blackjack wager and the optional Bet the Set wager.
 2. The dealer then follows house procedures for blackjack.
 3. Once you have two cards, the dealer settles the Bet the Set wagers. If you have a pair, you win according to the payable. Then you can either collect the proceeds or add all of them - or some of them - to your main blackjack bet and play the hand out.
- If your first two cards are not a pair you lose the Bet the Set wager.
